

COUNCIL REQUIREMENTS FOR FUTURE POP FESTIVALS.

1. Plans showing all relevant details must be forwarded to the Commission of Public Health and the Council at least 3 months prior to the date of the Festival and if approved all works are to be completed at least 5 days prior to the Festival.
2. Strict adherence to the Camping Regulations 1965 is necessary in both the setting up of camp sites per acre and adequate access roads must be provided to camp sites and toilet facilities.
3. Only vehicles that are necessary to service the facilities and organizers' vehicles should be allowed on site.
4. More water points should be provided than at the previous Festival and an adequate water supply must be assured.
5. More showering facilities must be provided.
6. More rubbish bins must be provided and more frequent servicing of these bins is to be provided.
7. More toilet facilities must be provided especially where crowd concentrations are greatest.  
  
It is evident from the amount of liquid refreshment available, that more urinals than previously provided are necessary.
8. Catering facilities must be approved and all mobile food vans to be used must be inspected prior to being allowed on site.
9. Medical facilities proved adequate at the previous festival and the same high standard should be insisted upon at all future festivals.
10. Back up facilities for all necessary utilities must be provided.
11. Once again a bond must be lodged with the Council.
12. These are all generalised points and any future proposition must be considered on its merits and a better liason with the Commission of Public Health must be set up from the onset.
