

AN OUTLINE OF THE HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL AND ASSEMBLY HALL

- 1953 Site purchased and decision made to establish the school by the Hon. A. E. SHEPHERD, Minister of Education.
- 1955 FEBRUARY — School started in various halls in Sunshine. Attendance about 200. Staff of 13. First Head Master, Mr. F. E. Lloyd, B.Sc., Dip. Ed., 1955-58.
MAY 2nd: Pupils and Staff moved into the new School, though it was not then completed.
- 1956 JUNE 13th — School officially opened by Hon. J. S. BLOOMFIELD, Minister of Education.
- 1959 School approved Class A for Leaving Certificate. Lawns, garden and tree-planting began.
- 1960 Matriculation classes began.
- 1963 Plans for sports grounds and hall formulated. Gardens completed.
- 1965 Sports grounds completed.
- 1968 JUNE: Hall completed and in use in July.

ASSEMBLY HALL

- 1963 Advisory Council members inspected a number of halls built at schools on a subsidy of £1 for £1 from Education Department and costing £25,000. Financing such a project did not seem possible at the time.
- 1964 Discussions with Education Department about a Hall as the Government had agreed to a subsidy of £3 for £1 with a limit of £30,000 This was increased to a limit of £36,000 in 1965.
- 1965 MARCH: Education Department requested to build a Hall, Type 572.
APRIL: Sunshine High School Co-Operative Society formed to finance the venture which was estimated to cost about £50,000. An appeal for financial assistance made to district organizations and industries had a good response, donations of £500 from H. V. McKay Charitable Trust, £250 from Massey-Ferguson and £100 from the City Council being among donations received.
- 1967 MAY: Contract let to T. W. Morris & Son for the building.
- 1967 JUNE: Building commenced.
- 1968 JUNE: Hall completed and ready for occupation.
Total cost of completed hall \$100,266. School's share: \$28,266.
Debt on Hall, 1969 is \$9,000 (approx.)
